Wide embroidered edging finishes the sleeve edges below a band of the eyelet insertion. The neck edge is finished with a mock piping technique using the serger rolled hem and a fabric binding. The back neck closes with a button and loop. **Pre-requisite:** Heirloom Sewing by Serger

Quilting Classes

Beginning Quilting – Nine Patch ✂

A quilting class designed for true beginner quilters. We will walk you through the process of selecting your fabric for the quilt. You will learn the basics of rotary cutting, assembling a basic 9-patch with strip piecing and finishing your quilt top with double borders. The last class will take your quilt top to a finished quilt. We'll discuss batting choices, making a quilt "sandwich", pin basting, quilting and binding. Loaner machines are available that include 1/4" foot, Walking Foot, and BSR foot (Bernina Stitch Regulator)
