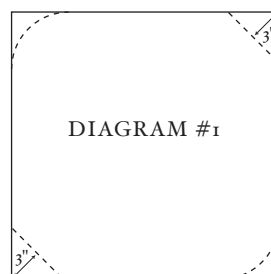


SNUGGLY CRITTER BLANKET



Supplies needed:

- A soft critter like TY® Pluffies.
- Two 20" x 20" pieces of Cuddle Soft fabric



Instructions:

To make the larger critter blanket with a larger animal use two 30" pieces.

Carefully cut the critter in half across the waistline. Remove a little of the stuffing and the bag of pellets in the bottom. Hand baste each half of body shut, gathering it so that it measures 3 ³/₄".

Square up the blanket pieces. It is best to lay them right sides together, **with the grain and nap (this is very important!!) going the same direction.** Cut a 3" (4" for the large bear) triangle piece off of two opposite corners. Using a saucer for your guide round the other two corners. Secure your edges with a few pins. See diagram #1.

Sew the top part of the body onto one squared corner and the feet onto the opposite one. Be sure to place them so both tummies are down on the piece you want to be the front. Place the fabric pieces right sides together, and sew around the blanket, leaving a space open for turning. Be sure the grain line is still going the same direction so the fabrics will not slip as much. Turn right side out, hand stitch the opening shut, then top stitch 5/8" around the blanket edge.

Enjoy your blanket. *Cuddle Soft* is really washable and so are the TY® Pluffies. They are very baby friendly.
