London Jacket

A Mary Ann Donze Design

An unlined, upper hip length jacket without closures, perfect as a fashion accent or a creative cover over any outfit. Construct with rounded neck uniquely trimmed with folded and stitched fabric strips. Two patch pockets are also trimmed in this manner. Also shown as a V-neck jacket with fabric ruffle around neck and front edges. Sizes S – 2XL

Materials List

View A

- 1 5/8 yards of 54"/60" wide fabric for all sizes
- OR
- 2 yards of 44" wide fabric for Sizes S, M, L
- 2 1/8 yards of 44" fabric for Sizes XL, 2XL
- 1/8 yard each of five contrasting fabrics OR one Bali Pop by Hoffman Fabrics OR one jellyroll, for fabric strip trim
- 2/3 yard of fusible interfacing
- Optional: One color of embroidery floss or pearl cotton to hand stitch through center of folded strips.

View B

- 1 5/8 yards of 54"/60" wide fabric for all sizes
- OR
- 2 yards of 44" wide fabric for Sizes S, M, L
- 2 1/8 yards of 44" wide fabric for Sizes XL, 2XL
- 1 1/8 yards of 44" wide fabric for contrasting ruffle trim
- 2/3 yard of fusible interfacing

Optional for both Views

1/2" bias tape maker (1/4" when folded in half) if adding bias binding to outer edges of facings or use 1-package (4-yards) of purchased 1/4" wide double fold bias binding to match fabric color.

Approximate bust measurement of finished garment

S – 41", **M** – 42 1/2", **L** – 44 1/2", **XL** – 46 1/2", **2XL** – 48 1/2"
