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Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric.

- 1-1/4 Yard - Patchwork Blocks (Y0390-29)
- 1-1/4 Yard - Sm. Tossed Newton (Y0392-29)
- 3/8 Yard - Pink Stars (Y0393-41)
- 1/2 Yard - Green Stars (Y0393-32)
- 1-1/4 Yards - Lg. Tossed Newton (Y0391-29)
- 1/2 Yard - Blue Stars (Y0393-29) (binding)
- 1/2 Yard - Yellow Stars (Y0393-8)
- 3-3/4 Yards - Backing of choice
- 1 Yard - Fusible Web

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

RS = Right Side of Fabric

WS = Wrong Side of Fabric

These quilt top measurements are based on the Patchwork Blocks being cut 1/4" outside the printed lines. Due to the fact that the printing may vary, before cutting the bold measurements listed here, measure the Patchwork strips for the pink stars and then the assembled quilt top as you add the borders.

From the Patchwork Blocks cut:

- 4- approximately 5-1/4" x 42-7/8" LOF strips.

Each strip should be two printed blocks across by seventeen printed block down with a 1/4" seam allowance added on all four sides.

From the Sm. Tossed Newton cut:

- 3 - 5-1/2" x 42-7/8" LOF strips

From the Pink Stars cut:

- 8 - 1" x 42-7/8" strips
- 2 - 1" x 38" strips

From the Green Stars cut:

- 5 - 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips and two 2-1/2" x 42" strips.

From the Lg. Tossed Newton cut:

- 6 - 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 6-1/2" x 47-1/2" strips and two 6-1/2" x 54" strips.

From the Blue Stars cut:

- 6 - 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

From the Yellow Stars cut:

See instructions before cutting

- 3 - large stars
- 3 - medium stars
- 4 - small stars

From the Backing cut:

- 2 - 64" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make one 64" x 66" piece for the backing.

Directions

Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

- 1) Sew one 1" x 42-7/8" Pink Stars strip to each side of one 5-1/4" x 42-7/8" Patchwork Block strip to make one patchwork strip. Repeat to make four patchwork strips total.
- 2) Starting and ending with one patchwork strip, sew together four patchwork strips and three 5-1/2" x 42-7/8" Sm. Tossed Newton strips, alternating them to make the quilt top.
- 3) Sew one 1" x 38" Pink Stars strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 4) Sew one 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" Green Stars strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 42" Green Stars strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 5) Sew one 6-1/2" x 47-1/2" Lg. Tossed Newton to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 6-1/2" x 54" Lg. Newton strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 6) Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace three large stars, three medium stars and four small stars onto the paper side of the fusible web.
- 7) Roughly cut out each shape about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 8) Press the star shapes onto the back side of the Yellow Stars fabric. Cut out each star on the drawn lines.
- 9) Refer to the quilt photo and scatter the stars across the quilt top as shown.
- 10) Finish the raw edges of each star with a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
- 11) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
