Partly Cloudy Poncho

Have fun in rain or shine with this easy-to-make, fully lined hooded poncho with snap or button closure options. It snaps or buttons at the sides forming armhole openings. Create this fashion statement using laminated fabrics, coordinating cottons or Home Dec fabrics. The finished poncho measures 33" from top of shoulder to bottom hem and is 42" wide; with a 15" hood. One size fits most.

Materials List

- 3 1/4 yards of 44" wide fabric for exterior
- 3 1/4 yards of 44" wide fabric for lining
- OR
- 2 1/2 yards of 54" wide fabric for exterior
- 2 1/2 yards of 54" wide fabric for lining
- OR
- 2 3/8 yards of 58" to 60" wide fabric for exterior
- 2 3/8 yards of 58" to 60" wide fabric for lining

Notions Required

- 8 - Size 24 (5/8") heavy duty snaps by Dritz
- OR
- Eight 3/4" to 1 1/4" buttons

Fabrics featured are Aqua Quarter Dot laminate by Michael Miller and Bones by Brandon Mably for Westminster Fibers.

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
